Description Notification requirements for persons who must register as sex offenders and who are on school premises and providing penalties					

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Currently, a person must register with the Department of Corrections (DOC) as a sex offender if they have been convicted of certain sex offenses, found not guilty of certain sex offenses by reason of mental disease or defect, or adjudicated delinquent on the basis of certain sex offenses. The registry also includes the name of any school in which the registrant is enrolled.

This bill generally prohibits a registrant from being in any school building, on any school grounds, school recreation area, or school athletic field, or on any school property unless the registrant notifies the school.

Prosecutors believe this adjustment in the law will not have a significant impact on their offices; and, will have little or no fiscal impact on the District Attorney program.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Prosecutors anticipate little or no long-term fiscal impact on their offices. Please see the analysis above.
