Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill reduces the deer, archery, sports and conservation patron license fees for Resident Senior Citizens who are at least 65 years of age.

Assumptions

A review the 2011 License Year data shows the following licenses sold to residents 65 years of age or older:

```
5,374 conservation patron licenses at $160.25 = $861,183.50
3,399 sports licenses at $57.25 = $194,592.75
45,818 deer licenses at $21.25 = $973,632.50
16,194 archery licenses $21.25 = $344,122.50
```

Reducing the fees for resident senior citizens will result in a decrease of \$816,700 in state licensing revenues, which is detailed below:

```
5,374 conservation patron licenses at $70.25 = $377,523.50, down $483,660 3,399 sports licenses at $32.25 = $109,617.75, down $84,975 45,818 deer licenses at $17.25 = $790,360.50, down $183,272 16,194 archery licenses at $17.25 = $279,346.50, down $64,776
```

In addition to the decrease in revenue, DNR estimates a one time cost of approximately 66,500 (700 hours x 95.00/hour) for system programming changes to the Automated License Issuance System (ALIS).
