Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The State Public Defender (SPD) is statutorily authorized and required to appoint attorneys to represent indigent defendants in criminal and certain commitment proceedings. The SPD plays a critical role in ensuring that the Wisconsin justice system complies with the right to counsel provided by both the state and federal constitutions. Any legislation has the potential to increase SPD costs if it creates a new criminal offense, expands the definition of an existing criminal offense, or increases the penalties for an existing offense.

This bill imposes registration and reporting requirements related to candidates running or who refer to running for state office. Also, this bill creates a clean elections fund to provide grants to qualifying candidates for campaign expenses. The bill provides that if a candidate does not adhere to the agreement required to obtain a clean election fund grant that the candidate is subject to a forfeiture (civil penalty).

The SPD provides representation only in those cases that carry the risk of criminal penalty. Because this bill only creates civil forfeiture penalties, the SPD would not provide representation upon violations of the bill's provisions.
