## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

If this bill were to be enacted it could result in a modest fiscal impact, primarily because defendants may be less likely to plead in such cases. Due to the uncertainty of how many cases could be involved, it is difficult to estimate what the fiscal impact would be.
