2011 Senate Bill 458 authorizes any municipality or county to adopt an ordinance under which traffic control attendants may be appointed for the protection of persons crossing highways at special events in the municipality or county.

Senate Amendment 1 removes the language in the bill relating to special events. Therefore, the amendment provides that a county's or municipality's authority is not limited to appointing traffic attendants to protect persons at or near special events.

Legislative History

Senate Amendment 1 was offered by Senator Lazich on February 16, 2012. On February 17, 2012, the Senate Committee on Transportation and Elections unanimously recommended adoption of the amendment and passage of Senate Bill 458, as amended.
