



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 71**

September 11, 2013 – Offered by Representative HEBL.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 5, line 12: after that line insert:

3 **“SECTION 10m. Nonstatutory provisions.**

4 (1) AUDIT OF COUNTIES AND AGENCIES AFFECTED BY CHANGES TO PENALTIES FOR
5 DRIVING A VEHICLE WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF AN INTOXICANT. The legislative audit
6 bureau shall perform a financial audit of counties, offices of district attorneys and
7 public defenders, and circuit courts to determine the fiscal and administrative costs
8 to the counties, offices, and courts to prosecute actions that are punishable under
9 section 346.65 (2) (am) 3. to 7. of the statutes, as affected by this act. The legislative
10 audit bureau shall prepare a report of its findings and recommendations for
11 addressing any negative consequences of the changes to sentencing under the
12 affected statutes. No later than 18 months after the effective date of this subsection,
13 the legislative audit bureau shall submit copies of the audit report and its

1 recommendations to the chief clerk of each house of the legislature for distribution
2 to the appropriate standing committees under section 13.172 (3) of the statutes.”.
