Matt, specifically regarding AB 10, that bill included only a nonstatutory direction to Commerce to allocate certain moneys from an existing economic development appropriation for manufacturing forums. However, DOA does not have a current appropriation that would clearly cover the creation and organization of manufacturer forums for economic development. Your options are:

1. Direct WEDC, not DOA, to allocate those moneys from one of its existing economic development appropriations. Doing it this way would mean the bill could remain entirely nonstatutory.
2. Direct DOA to establish the manufacturer forums and have the draft either create a new appropriation for doing so or add a new purpose to an existing appropriation. Doing it this way would mean DOA funds and runs the forums, but it also means creating statutory, as opposed to nonstatutory, language for the draft.

Please let me know how you would like to proceed.

Michael,

I left a voice message late this afternoon regarding additional changes requested by Rep. Stone to the draft **2013 LRB 0859/1**.

These changes are requested following consultation with Rep. Andy Jorgensen.

Changes are as follows:

1) Change Department of Administration to Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation

2) Create a Supply-Chain Marketing Fund → *sub-refers to program.*

MPG—What do you mean by "fund"? Do you want a statutory fund created in ch. 25? Or, do you just want a program under WEDC that does something related to supply-chain marketing? In any case, can you describe what you want WEDC to do concerning supply-chain marketing? Is this supposed to be a grant to the association under the draft? Please describe with specificity what you want WEDC to do with the \$250,000 so I can put that in the draft.

*LA Grant as either/or*

3) Deposit \$250,000 into the Fund effective January 1, 2014. MPG—See my questions regarding the "fund" above. Do you want to create a new appropriation for this \$250,000, or do you want WEDC to use moneys for this program/fund from one of its existing appropriations for economic development? ✓

4) Create marketing program for plan development

MPG—Please explain what this means. What is "plan development"? Is this related to supply-chain marketing, or is it something different? ✓

5) WEDC will conduct an annual review of the Fund

MPG—See my questions regarding the “fund” above. Do you want to require a report, or do you only want to include an annual review or audit requirement?

In addition, Rep. Stone requests the following changes to the draft **2013 LRB 0860/1**:

1) Change Department of Administration to Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation

2) Conduct an expo/trade show *→ want this included as part of the marketing aspects?*

MPG—Please describe the difference between an “expo/trade show” and the “trade and marketing forums” under the current draft. Is the “expo/trade show” intended to replace the “trade and marketing forums” in the draft, or is it intended that the “expo/trade show” be in addition to the “trade and marketing forums” in the draft?

3) Allocate \$100,000 in current biennium for expo

MPG—Is this money in addition to the \$100,000 already appropriated in the draft?

4) Proceeds from expo will be applied to the Supply-Chain Marketing Fund

MPG—Please see my questions concerning the “supply-chain marketing fund” above. Also, if you want the proceeds to go to the “supply-chain marketing fund,” then it may be necessary to combined these two drafts because the “supply-chain marketing fund” does not exist yet under current law. I can only draft a bill to current law. By proceeds, do you mean proceeds in addition to WEDC’s cost to put on the show, or do you mean gross proceeds?


