Hi, Aaron,

Representative Larson would like a bill drafted that would permit the Town of Union in Eau Claire County to issue one Class B liquor license in addition to the Class B licenses authorized under the town's quota.

(A little background – the town had told this one Mexican restaurant that it still had a license available, so the restaurant put a bunch of money into renovating the facilities, only to be told that the town had been mistaken and was really out of licenses. The restaurant's landlord, who brought this to our attention, said town officials have said they'd be willing to issue a license to the facility if they have the authority to do so. He says the restaurant is cleared to sell beer and wine, but the problem is that it can't serve margaritas.)

1 AN ACT ...; relating to: allowing the town of Union in Eau Claire County to exceed
2 its retail liquor license quota by issuing one additional retail license.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law prohibits a person from selling alcohol beverages at retail unless the seller possesses a license or permit authorizing the sale. A "Class B" license authorizes the retail sale of intoxicating liquor for consumption on the retail premises and, subject to various restrictions, the retail sale of intoxicating liquor in original packages for consumption off the retail premises. Current law imposes a quota on the number of "Class B" licenses that a municipality may issue. This quota is generally determined by a formula based on the number of licenses previously issued by the municipality and the municipality's population. Current law also provides a limited number of quota exceptions.

This bill allows the town of Union in Eau Claire County to issue one "Class B" license in addition to the "Class B" licenses authorized under the town's quota.

For further information see the local fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
