

1 AN ACT ...; relating to: monitoring industrial sand mining and processing  
2 operations and making an appropriation.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill authorizes eight full time equivalent positions to the Department of Natural Resources for monitoring industrial sand mining and processing operations and provides funding for those positions from the environmental fund.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3 SECTION 1. Fiscal changes.

4 (1) INDUSTRIAL SAND OPERATION MONITORING. In the schedule under section  
5 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of natural  
6 resources under section 20.270 (3) (mq) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2013,  
7 the dollar amount is increased by \$446,800 for the first fiscal year of the fiscal  
8 biennium in which this subsection takes effect to increase the authorized FTE
