Create a Sum Sufficient Appropriation for the WHEG-TCS Program

Motion:

Move to create a sum sufficient appropriation for the Wisconsin higher education grant (WHEG) program for technical college students to fully fund grants to eligible applicants based on the 2011-12 HEAB formula for determining WHEG-TCS award amounts. Estimate expenditures at \$48,826,600 GPR in each year of the biennium.

---

Note:

The WHEG-TCS program provides need-based grants to resident undergraduate students enrolled at least half-time in those institutions. Under current law, the WHEG-TCS program is funded through a sum certain appropriation which was set at \$18,797,900 in 2011-12 and 2012-13 and would be set the same level under the bill. Students who are eligible for grants based on their financial need but who apply after the funding provided has been fully committed are placed on a waitlist. In 2011-12, 54,812 applicants were eligible for WHEG-TCS grants based on their financial need but were not awarded grants due to lack of available funding. Of these applicants, it is estimated that 31,906 would have enrolled and received grants if additional funding were available. This estimate based on the percentage of applicants who were awarded WHEG-TCS grants and enrolled in a technical college. Based on an average grant award of \$941, it is estimated that providing grants to these students would have cost \$30,028,700 in 2011-12. This estimate assumes that the same formula would be used to award WHEG-TCS grants in 2013-14 and 2014-15 as was used in 2011-12. Because the appropriation would be sum sufficient, actual expenditures could exceed estimated expenditures if additional students apply and enroll or if the average grant was greater than \$941.

Wisconsin Higher Education grants (WHEG) grants

1 AN ACT to amend 20.235 (1) (ff), 20.285 (1) (gb), 20.285 (1) (gb), 39.435 (8) and  
2 39.435 (8); and to create 20.235 (1) (kd) of the statutes; relating to: funding  
3 for Wisconsin higher education grants for University of Wisconsin System and  
4 technical college students and making appropriations.

**Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau**

~~Under current law, \$58,345,400 is transferred from the University of Wisconsin (UW) System to the Higher Educational Aids Board (HEAB) and appropriated for Wisconsin higher education grants (WHEG grants) for UW System students in fiscal year 2013-14 and a sum sufficient of general purpose revenues are appropriated to HEAB for those grants in fiscal year 2014-15. This bill, in addition, transfers \$20,370,300 in each fiscal year from the UW System to HEAB and appropriates those moneys for WHEG grants for UW System students.~~

Under current law, there is appropriated to HEAB \$20,797,900 in fiscal year 2013-14 and \$18,797,900 in fiscal year 2014-15 for WHEG grants for technical college students. This bill converts that appropriation to a sum sufficient appropriation, but caps the amount that may be expended from that appropriation in each of fiscal years 2013-14 and 2014-15 at the amount necessary to fund WHEG grants for all eligible technical college students who apply for those grants as determined under the same formula that HEAB used to award those grants in fiscal year 2011-12.

**SECTION 1.** 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place, insert the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

20.235 (1) (ff) *Wisconsin higher education grants; technical college students.* Biennially, the amounts in the schedule A sum sufficient for the Wisconsin higher education grant program under s. 39.435 for technical college students, except for grants awarded under s. 39.435 (2) or (5). In each of fiscal years 2013-14 and 2014-15, the amount that may be expended from this appropriation may not exceed the amount necessary to fund Wisconsin higher education grants for all eligible technical college students who apply for those grants as determined under the same formula under s. 39.285 (1) that the higher educational aids board used to award those grants in fiscal year 2011-12.
