Hi Marcie,

Below is what we agreed to with Rep. Thiesfeldt. They said if drafting can turn it around by 9 am monday, then we could conceivably exec on Tuesday. As always, if Becky at LRB has questions, she can call me direct if that's OK with you. Please give me a yell with any questions/concerns.

- ✓ **Create an additional exemption for existing Class C exhibitor's license holders under 7 U.S.C. Section 2131 located in counties with a population of 50,000 or less that have not been cited by the USDA for exhibiting without a Class C license.**
- ✓ **A person exempt under the amendment is prohibited from breeding (unlike those exempt under the bill).**
- ✓ **A person exempt under the amendment may not obtain additional "dangerous exotic animals" in excess of the total number of "dangerous exotic animals" possessed at time of enactment. (i.e., they can replace animals that die, but cannot exceed their current number)**
- ✓ **A person who possesses a dangerous animal via the grandfather provisions must provide proof of spaying or neutering with registration.**
- ✓ **A person who possesses a dangerous animal by way of the exemption in this amendment must be able to prove that exempt animals are spayed or neutered to qualify for exemption.**

10 inserts date], and has not been cited by the federal department of agriculture for  
11 exhibiting without a license.

Some considerations for the amendment language you received from Marcie... please see below. Prevention measures shouldn't be limited to just spay or neuter because that's not always the best way with some of the covered species. Also, we don't want to mandate it on animals that can't reproduce for other reasons. Please call me with any questions.

- > A person who possesses a dangerous animal via the grandfather provisions must provide proof of preventive reproductive measures with registration.

- > A person who possesses a dangerous animal by way of the amendment must be able to provide proof of preventive reproductive measures to qualify for exemption.
- >
- > Preventive reproductive measures may be one of the following certifications from a veterinarian annually:
  - >
  - > \* males and females are housed separately.
  - >
  - > \* an animal is too elderly to reproduce.
  - >
  - > \* an animal is placed on a chemical contraceptive
  - >
  - > \* an animal has been surgically altered to prevent reproduction
  - >
  - > \* an animal is unable to reproduce due to a permanent or chronic medical condition
  - >
