AB 737 (Driver's Ed Plus)

- 1) Require any vender that contracts with the DOT to establish and maintain a scholarship program where persons that are determined to be indigent under state law may participate at a reduced cost
- 2) ~~Require any vender that contracts with the DOT to establish and maintain a payment plan program where persons that meet 200% of the General Poverty Guidelines or less be afforded the opportunity to pay for the exam in a payment schedule~~
- 3) ~~Require any vender that contracts with the DOT to establish and maintain an in-person classroom component in a city of the first class~~

D-Note

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 6, line 3: after that line insert:

3 “(f) Establish and maintain a scholarship program that provides a reduced fee
4 for participation in a driver improvement course by a person to whom any of the
5 following applies:

6 1. The person is a recipient of means-tested public assistance, including aid to
7 families with dependent children, relief funded by a relief block grant under ch. 49,
8 relief provided by counties under s. 59.53 (21), medical assistance, supplemental
9 security income, food stamps or benefits received by veterans under s. 45.40 (1m).

10 2. The person is represented by an attorney through a legal services program
11 for indigent persons, including, without limitation, those funded by the federal legal
12 services corporation, the state public defender, or volunteer attorney programs based
13 on indigency.
