1 **Relating to:** the life and military service of United States Army First Lieutenant
2 David Andrew Johnson.

3 Whereas, David was born on November 28, 1987, in Beloit, Wisconsin, to
4 Andrew and Laura Johnson, and died on January 25, 2012, in Kandahar Province,
5 Afghanistan, while conducting a dismounted patrol; and

6 Whereas, David was a 2006 graduate of Mayville High School in Mayville,
7 Wisconsin, attended Evangel University in Springfield, Missouri, graduating in
8 2010 with a Bachelor of Science degree, and completed his basic training in the
9 United States Army at Fort Sill in Oklahoma in 2006; and

10 Whereas, in 2007 David completed his AIT Chaplain Assistant training in Fort
11 Jackson, South Carolina, and was awarded an ROTC scholarship with the Bear
12 Battalion associated with Missouri State University in Springfield, Missouri. David
13 was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in May 2010. In January 2011, David
14 graduated from the Infantry Basic Officer Leadership Course at Fort Benning,

1 Georgia. He also completed Combatives Level I and II and the Stryker Brigade
2 Combat Team Leader's Course; and

3 Whereas, David served with distinction in the United States Army 5th
4 Battalion, 20th Infantry Regiment, 3rd Stryker Brigade Combat Team, 2nd Infantry
5 Division, Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington; and

6 Whereas, David embodied the Army's core values of loyalty, duty, respect,
7 selfless service, honor, integrity, and personal service and he is sorely missed; and

8 Whereas, David was the beloved son of Andrew and Laura Johnson; brother to
9 Michael, Matthew, and Emily; and dear friend to many, and his family and fellow
10 citizens are proud to have known him and admire his devotion to family, faith, and
11 country; now, therefore, be it

12 **Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That** the legislature of
13 the state of Wisconsin commemorates the remarkable life of David Andrew Johnson
14 and extends its deepest sympathies to his family, friends, and colleagues; and, be it
