October 18, 2011 - Introduced by Representatives MILROY, PASCH, BALLWEG, BARCA, BEWLEY, HEBL, HINTZ, JACQUE, JORGENSEN, KAUFERT, KERKMAN, MASON, RINGHAND, SINICKI, SPANBAUER and BERNARD SCHABER, cosponsored by Senators LASSA, MILLER and VINEHOUT. Referred to Committee on Rules.

- 1 **Relating to: Pregnancy and Infant Loss Awareness Month.**
- 2 Whereas, each year, over one million pregnancies in the United States end in
- 3 miscarriage, stillbirth, the death of a newborn baby, or sudden infant death
- 4 syndrome and one in every three pregnancies worldwide ends in loss; and
- 5 Whereas, the loss of a child's life is a great tragedy and a traumatic event that
- 6 brings a family pain, suffering, and grief; and
- 7 Whereas, since 2002, governors of all 50 states have signed proclamations
- 8 designating Pregnancy and Infant Loss Remembrance Day; and
- 9 Whereas, every year people around the world participate in the International
- 10 Wave of Light which invites participants to light a candle for pregnancy loss and
- 11 infant loss remembrance starting at 1900 hours on October 15 in their respective
- 12 time zones, and to leave the candle burning for at least one hour to create a
- 13 continuous chain of light spanning the globe for a 24-hour period in honor and
- 14 remembrance of the children who die during pregnancy or shortly after birth; and
