

WHEREAS, Glenn E. Pommerening, Jr. was born September 27, 1927 in Milwaukee; and

WHEREAS, Glenn received his bachelor degree in 1950 and a Bachelor of Laws in 1953 from the University of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, Glenn was on the board of directors for the Wisconsin 4-H Foundation and Milwaukee Rescue Mission; and

WHEREAS, Glenn was elected to the Wisconsin State Assembly in 1954 serving six terms; and

WHEREAS, Glenn became Chairman of the Joint Finance Committee, 1963, and Chairman of the Assembly Policy Committee, 1961; and

WHEREAS, Glenn served also as Chairman on the Assembly Commerce and Manufacturing Committee, the Election Committee and the Taxation Committee; and

WHEREAS, Glenn became Vice-Chairman of the Board on Government Operations and State Building Commission; and

WHEREAS, Glenn served on the Committees of Tax Compromise, Claims, Judgment Debtor Relief, Legislative Organization and Procedure, Legislative Council and its "Committee of 25";

WHEREAS, Glenn served on the Governor's Blue Ribbon Committee on Tax Policy, Tax Sources and Incidence Subcommittee, and Continuing Revenue Survey Committee; and

WHEREAS, Glenn was appointed Deputy Secretary of Administration for Governor Warren Knowles in 1966; and

WHEREAS, Glenn moved to McLean, Virginia and worked as Deputy Assistant Attorney General for the United States Justice Department; and

WHEREAS, Glenn was transferred to the Federal Bureau of Prisons as the Deputy Assistant Director until he retired in 1988; and

WHEREAS, Glenn raised four children: William, Philip, David, and Jean;

WHEREAS, Glenn E. Pommerening, Jr. passed away on September 10th, 2013 at the age of 85 in his home in Alexandria, VA; therefore, be it
