**Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau**

This bill requires the Department of Health Services (DHS) to award grants to counties to contract with peer-run organizations to establish peer-run respite centers for individuals experiencing mental health conditions or substance abuse. The total amount of general purpose revenue appropriated to be awarded as grants is \$250,000 under the bill. For each grant awarded, DHS shall award the county an amount that is one-half the amount the county provides to contract with the peer-run organization to establish peer-run respite centers.

For further information see the **state and local** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

**The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:**

- 3 SECTION 1. 46.48 (32) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 46.48 (32) PEER-RUN RESPITE CENTER CONTRACTS. The department shall award
- 5 grants to counties to contract with a peer-run organization to establish peer-run
- 6 respite centers for individuals experiencing mental health conditions or substance

13 the dollar amount is increased by \$125,000 for the second fiscal year of the fiscal  
14 biennium in which this subsection takes effect to provide grants to counties to  
15 contract with peer-run organizations to establish peer-run respite centers.
