

**Wisconsin Historical Society  
Statutory Language Proposal: Unclassified Position Change**

Summary

The Wisconsin Historical Society proposes two revisions to the Wisconsin Statutes regarding its unclassified position authority. The revisions would not require any additional funding or FTE authority, but would merely change a division administrator position to an executive assistant position. Wis. Stat. § 230.08(2)(e)5m. allows the Historical Society five division administrator positions. Currently, and for the foreseeable future, the Historical Society has only four divisions, resulting in one unnecessary and unusable unclassified position. The Historical Society has a strong need for a specialized position to assist the Director in the management and oversight of Society high-priority projects, one such project is the new Museum to be shared with the Department of Veteran's Affairs. Under Wis. Stat. § 15.05(3), many other agency secretaries have the ability to "appoint an executive assistant to serve at his or her pleasure outside the classified service". In this statute, "secretary" includes the attorney general, the adjutant general, the director of the technical college system, and the state superintendent of public instruction. The Historical Society proposes adding the Director of the Historical Society to this list. The cumulative effect of the revisions would be to remove an unclassified division administrator position and add an unclassified executive assistant position.

**230.08 Classification of civil service.**

**(2) UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE.** The unclassified service comprises positions held by:

**(e)** The number of division administrator positions as specified in this paragraph for any board, department or commission as defined in sub. (4) (a) and s. 15.01 (5), and for the historical society with specific functional assignments to be determined by the appointing authority, except as otherwise provided in sub. (4) or as otherwise provided by law:

(5m. Historical society — 5.4.

**15.05 Secretaries.**

**(3)** Executive assistant. Each secretary may appoint an executive assistant to serve at his or her pleasure outside the classified service. The executive assistant shall perform duties as the secretary prescribes. In this subsection, "secretary" includes the attorney general, the adjutant general, the director of the technical college system, ~~and~~ the state superintendent of public instruction and the director of the historical society.

Fiscal Impact

There will be no fiscal impact.

Alternatives

The Historical Society would retain one unusable, unclassified division administrator position, and the Director would not be granted the authority to appoint an executive assistant to manage and oversee special projects.






