Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

CRIMES

Under current law, the department of justice (DOJ) transfers a certain amount of money it receives from crime laboratory surcharges, drug law enforcement surcharges, and deoxyribonucleic acid analysis surcharges to an appropriation that funds activities relating to drug law enforcement, drug law violation prosecution assistance, and activities of the state and regional crime laboratories.

*

This bill requires that any unencumbered balance at the end of each fiscal year in the appropriation account that funds activities relating to drug law enforcement, drug law violation prosecution assistance, and activities of the state and regional crime laboratories be transferred back to DOJ.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.455 (2) (kd) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.455 (2) (kd) *Drug law enforcement, crime laboratories, and genetic evidence*

activities. The amounts in the schedule for activities relating to drug law

1 enforcement, drug law violation prosecution assistance, activities of the state and
 2 regional crime laboratories, and for transferring to the appropriation account under
 3 s. 20.475 (1) (km) the amounts in the schedule under s. 20.475 (1) (km). All moneys
 4 transferred to this appropriation from the appropriation account under par. (Lm)
 5 shall be credited to this appropriation account. Notwithstanding s. 20.001 (3) (a),
 6 unencumbered balance on June 30 of each year shall revert to the appropriation
 7 account under 20.455 (2m) (Lm). ^{par.}
