CORRECTIONS

Current law requires DOC to have a revolving fund consisting of money DOC has that belongs to persons on probation, parole, or extended supervision who have absconded or whose whereabouts are unknown. DOC must use the fund to defray certain expenses for persons on probation, parole, and extended supervision who are without means, and the persons on probation, parole, and extended supervision must repay the money if possible. This bill eliminates the requirement that DOC have such a revolving fund.

This bill also consolidates some appropriation ⁵ accounts with similar purposes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.410 (1) (g) of the statutes is repealed.

All moneys received from each person on account of these services shall be used for operation of the institutions under s. 20.410 (1) (a) and (3) (a), and (hm) ~~and~~ (j). If a chaplain employed in any institution administered by the department is not furnished a residence by the state, \$1,800 or 20% of the chaplain's salary, whichever is greater, is designated as his or her housing allowance.
