MENTAL ILLNESS AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES

Under current law, DHS operates the Mendota Juvenile Treatment Center, which is located on the grounds of the Mendota Mental Health Institute. The center provides psychological and psychiatric evaluations and treatment for juveniles whose behavior presents a serious problem to themselves or others in other juvenile correctional facilities and whose mental health needs can be met at the center. Currently, DOC is required to transfer \$2,890,700 in fiscal year 2011-12 and \$2,964,000 in fiscal year 2012-13 from a certain appropriation account to DHS for services for juveniles placed at the center. This bill changes the amounts of those transfers to \$2,707,100 in fiscal year 2013-14 and \$2,772,800 in fiscal year 2014-15.
