

Peter Kirby:

As requested, this bill reduces wolf harvesting approval fees by 50 percent. In your instructions, you indicated that by reducing these fees by 50 percent, they would be similar to fees charged for elk approvals. Please note that the reduction in fees in this draft causes the wolf harvesting fees to be similar to, but not exactly the same as elk approval fees. ↑

Also, with respect to fees for duplicate approvals, the fees in the draft as reduced by 50 percent are higher than the fees for a duplicate elk approval. The draft reduces the fee for a wolf harvesting duplicate approval issued to a resident from \$50 to \$25. The draft reduces the fee for a wolf harvesting duplicate approval issued to a resident from \$250 to \$125. Under current law, a duplicate elk approval is \$13, regardless of whether it is issued to a resident or a nonresident.

In your instructions, you indicated that by reducing these fees by 50 percent, they would be similar to fees charged for elk approvals. Please note that the reduction in fees in this draft causes the wolf harvesting fees to be similar to, but not exactly the same as, elk approval fees.

Also, with respect to fees for duplicate approvals, the fees in the draft as reduced by 50 percent are higher than the fees for a duplicate elk approval. The draft reduces the fee for a wolf harvesting duplicate approval issued to a resident from \$50 to \$25. The draft reduces the fee for a wolf harvesting duplicate approval issued to a resident from \$250 to \$125. Under current law, a duplicate elk approval is \$13, regardless of whether it is issued to a resident or a nonresident.
