

In the Division of Public Health in the Department of Health Services, please create a grant program to assist groups of hospitals in procuring the infrastructure and increasing volume so that they may have a viable accreditation application in order to provide the necessary experience for a resident physician.

The grant program is open to the following eligible recipients: Hospitals, or groups of hospitals, with plans for increasing infrastructure and case volume in order to develop a resident physician program for accreditation. Each grant will be 3 years.

Create a new GPR annual, amounts in the schedule, aids to individuals/orgs appropriation in DHS program 1 (Public Health) from which to award the grants.
