Intent:

Revise or augment s. 115.297 to add DCF and DWD to the agencies that must collaborate on student data sharing.

By the first day of the third month after the budget is passed, the agencies in s. 115.297, DCF and DWD would enter into an agreement to do all of the things specified in the section (or the current agreement would be amended to add DCF and DWD and make other changes as necessary).

I think that this would also require a change to 3(a) insofar as DWD is involved. The intent is to allow tracking of individuals after postsecondary education (if they come into the unemployment system, for example). Perhaps we add a section that, in addition to requiring the data system for preschool to postsecondary, requires the agencies to ensure interoperability between the educational data systems and the workforce data systems in order to permit linking of data?


