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

Here are our updated requests. I referenced my original email requests. This is the first installment (I am working on the rest, but in the interest of time) Please call me with any questions—I will be here all day in into the evening. We are going to have 25 amendments total, this is the first 13.

Amendment 1. Jobs Package. Please include the following as one amendment. (all already requested, references noted).

These were originally items 2-7 on Amendment Request #2.

This was originally item 5 under new requests, Amendment Request #3.

- Fully fund the state building program. This would delete item #6 in motion #534.

This was originally the Agriculture Package, Item 9 under new requests, Amendment Request #3.

- Agriculture Package.
 - Restore grazing lands conservation funding. LFB Paper #145, Alternative 6. [Cost \$750,000]
 - Restore cut to the Agriculture Development and Diversification Program. [Cost \$642,000]
 - Provide \$500,000 in additional funding for the Farm to School program. [Cost \$500,000]
 - Provide funding for Johne's Disease Testing Assistance (restore cut). [Cost \$422,400]
 - Restore funding for the Agricultural Education and Workforce Development Council (AEWDC).
The budget removes all expenditure authority associated with the AEWDC. [Cost \$19,300]

This was originally requested by Cindy McGinnis on 6.13.13. Please only include only items 1, 2, 4 (not item 3 regarding attendance based authorization).

- Realign the reimbursement tiers for the YoungStar program to coincide with where they were in December 2010. Begin realignment begins upon enactment of the bill or 7/1/13 whichever is sooner. Also increase the base rate by 7%. (see attached LFB memo on this)
 - 2 Star providers maintain base level funding

- 3 Star providers receive a 5% increase
- 4 Star providers receive a 10% increase
- 5 Star providers receive a 25% increase
- Remove all provisions for the EBT payment system for W2 and child care providers. Just go back to the current system.
- Swap the \$37.7 million in new TANF funds that were used for EITC for GPR. Use these TANF funds to pay for item #1 above, as well as more money for mini-grants and more money for TEACH and REWARD. Please let me know how much is left over after we pay for item #1 above and I'll figure out how to divide it between TEACH/REWARD and the mini-grants.

This was originally Item 29, Amendment Request #4.

- Restore funding and positions at the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission. LFB Paper #265, alternative 4.

Amendment 2. (Originally in Amendment Request #4, Item 1). NO CHANGES TO THIS AMENDMENT. Remove all Non-Fiscal Items in the Budget. This would include all items outlined in this LFB memo that remain in the budget: http://legis.wisconsin.gov/lfb/publications/budget/2013-15%20Budget/Documents/Joint%20Finance/2013_06_11%20WILEG%20Non-Fiscal%20Policy.pdf.

Amendment 3. (Originally in Amendment Request #4, Item 16). Restore the Center for Investigative Journalism and UW. This would delete item 2 on Page 1 of Motion #999.

Amendment 4. (Originally Amendment Request #1, under Other, Item 4). Remove Bail Bond Provisions. Delete Item #14, Motion #999.

Amendment 5. Two Parts. 1) (Originally Amendment Request #1, under Revenue and Taxation, Item 3) Remove the Individual Income Tax Deduction for Private School Tuition. Delete Item #29, Motion #999. 2) Eliminate the voucher expansion to new school districts.

Amendment 6. (Originally Amendment Request #1, under Education, Item 2). Require a school district to pass a referendum approving voucher expansion to the district before any students in that district can participate in the voucher program.

Amendment 7. (Originally Amendment Requests #5, Items 3-8). Please combine the request for a referendum in districts that are all or partially in Door, Brown, Kewaunee, Calumet, Sheboygan, Manitowoc, Fond du Lac, Juneau, Richland, Sauk, Iowa, Grant, LaFayette, Winnebago, Outagamie, Chippewa, Dunn, Eau Claire, Clark, Marathon, Wood, Marathon, Rusk, Sawyer, Taylor, Shawano, Portage. Same drafting instructions to Tracy Kuczynski.

Amendment 8. Three Items—1) (Originally Amendment Request #1, under education, Item 1) Public School Funding Increase \$275 per pupil/year. Same as Motion #585.; 2) Increase Special education funding to \$20 million (\$3 million for high cost special ed, \$17 million for special ed)—this is a slight modification from original request. 3) revenue limit exemption for school safety (only this item).

Amendment 9. (Originally Amendment Request #1, Item 1, Under Health Care). Implementation of MA Expansion (133/133). LFB Paper #321, Alternative 2

Amendment 10. Implementation of MA Expansion (133/133). LFB Paper #321, Alternative 2. We ask that this amendment sunset the MA expansion after **three** years.

Amendment 11. Implementation of MA Expansion (133/133). LFB Paper #321, Alternative 2. We ask that this amendment sunset the MA expansion after **two** year.

Amendment 12. Implementation of MA Expansion (133/133). LFB Paper #321, Alternative 2. We ask that this amendment sunset the MA expansion after **one** years.

Amendment 13. Expand Family Care to NE Wisconsin and Waushara County; Offset Older American Act Funding Reductions for Select Counties and Tribes for two years. Originally Amendment Request #3, Item 2 under health care—please add Waushara County. Originally Amendment Request #7, Item 1.
