5 made.

6 **2.** Page 1024, line 5: substitute "\$275" for "\$75".

7 **3.** Page 1024, line 8: delete "make no adjustment" and substitute "add the  
8 result in s. 121.91 (2m) (i) 1g."

9 **4.** Page 1024, line 17: substitute "\$275" for "\$75".



9 under sub. (2m) for the following school year.”

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute  
2 amendment 1, as follows:

3 **1.** Page 139, line 7: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2013-14 by  
4 \$8,500,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2014-15 by \$8,500,000 to  
5 increase funding for special education aid.

6 **2.** Page 139, line 10: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2013-14 by  
7 \$1,500,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2014-15 by \$1,500,000 to  
8 increase funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.
