Sen. Vinehout would like an amendment to AB 35 drafted for floor action tomorrow.

The amendment should exempt on-premise sign-related secondary wiring including the manufacture, installation and maintenance of on-premise signs.

On-premise signs are signs located on the business premise, as opposed to outdoor billboards. Secondary wiring is the wiring within the sign itself and includes the individual sign components. It does not include the wiring from the electrical source to the sign.
