**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT ,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 14**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 3, line 18: delete "From" and substitute "(a) From".

2. Page 3, line 20: delete lines 20 to 22 and substitute "workforce training programs that help meet local needs for supporting sectors of the economy with a documented skills gap or a high workforce shortage, which could include manufacturing, energy, information technology, skilled trades, and health care.

(b) An organization that is awarded a grant under this subsection may use the grant for activities that address the development of individuals prior to entering the workforce and for incumbent workforce training, which activities and training could include any one or more of the following:

- 11 1. Job training scholarships based on local labor market needs.
- 12 2. Building or infrastructure construction.
- 13 3. Equipment and material purchases.
