6 vehicle used by the sanitation worker<sup>s</sup> is displaying flashing, oscillating, or rotating  
7 warning lights, and the operator knows or should know that sanitation workers are  
8 present, any applicable minimum and maximum forfeiture or fine specified in sub.
