# SENATE BILL 1

October 14, 2013 - Introduced by COMMITTEE ON SENATE ORGANIZATION, by request of Governor Scott Walker. Referred to Joint Committee on Finance.

**AN ACT relating to:** school district budgets and making an appropriation.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill increases the amount appropriated as general school aid in the 2013-14 and 2014-15 school years. The bill also delays the dates by which school districts must determine the amounts necessary to be raised to operate and maintain the schools in 2013 from November 1 to November 6.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

2 SECTION. Nonstatutory provisions.

INS. SA2-3 ✓

3 (1) (a) Notwithstanding section 121.15 (4) (b) of the statutes, the state  
4 superintendent of public instruction shall calculate the total amount of state aid that  
5 each school district will receive in the 2013-14 school year by October 31, 2013,  
6 instead of on October 15, 2013.

7 (b) Notwithstanding section 120.12 (3) and (4) of the statutes, for 2013 the  
8 references to November 1 in those sections are changed to November 6.





**SENATE AMENDMENT 2,  
TO 2013 SENATE BILL 1**

October 15, 2013 – Offered by Senator PETROWSKI.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 1: after “budgets” insert “, the school district levy for community  
3 programs and services,”.

4 **2.** Page 1, line 2: before that line insert:

5 **SECTION 1d.** 2013 Wisconsin Act 20, section 9134 (4L) (g) is created to read:  
6 [2013 Wisconsin Act 20] Section 9134 (4L) (g) 1. Notwithstanding paragraph  
7 (b) 1., if a school board levied more for community programs and services in 2011 than  
8 it levied for community programs and services in 2012, its limit under paragraph (b)  
9 1. is the amount it levied for community programs and services in 2011, except as  
10 provided in subdivision 2.

11 2. Subdivision 1. applies only if the school board’s levy for community programs  
12 and services in 2011 or 2012 was less than \$1,000,000. *el*
