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

(8) "Full-time undergraduate" means a veteran who has not received a baccalaureate degree and who is either enrolled at a college, university, or public vocational-technical school in a course of instruction which such school's veterans official or financial aids officer certifies to be full time or is enrolled at a proprietary trade or technical school in a course of instruction which qualifies as full-time for VA educational benefits.

(14) "Unearned income" means the estimated amount the veteran and spouse will receive during the academic year from VA educational assistance allowance (G.I. Bill) benefits, scholarships, fellowships, grants, tuition and fee waivers, all other definite awards other than loans, including amounts paid to the veteran or to the school on behalf of the veteran for vocational rehabilitation by the VA or any other agency, income from trusts or inheritances, unemployment compensation, worker's compensation, social security payments, net rentals from real estate, interest or dividend income or other unearned income but shall not include disability compensation paid to the veteran by the VA for service-connected disabilities, armed forces disability retirement pay, or parental contributions.

How to apply

Every term, all students who are eligible to receive federal veterans' educational benefits (new and continuing) must complete the following university form:

- # Application for Certification of VA Educational Benefits

First-time use of benefits

If you have never used your Veterans' Affairs educational benefits, you will need to provide documentation of your eligibility to receive them.

Required documents:

- # Chapter 30: Montgomery GI Bill-Active Duty — copy of Certificate of Eligibility and a copy of your DD 214 (Certificate of Discharge).
- # Chapter 31: Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment — consult with a Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor at the Department of Veterans' Affairs Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment Office.
- # Chapter 33: Post-9/11 GI Bill — copy of Certificate of Eligibility.
- # Chapter 33: Yellow Ribbon Program — the Yellow Ribbon GI Education Enhancement Program is a provision of the Post-9/11 GI Bill. This program allows institutions of higher learning in the United States to voluntarily enter into an agreement with the VA to partially or fully fund tuition and fee expenses that exceed the established thresholds under the Post-9/11 GI Bill.
- # Chapter 35: Survivors' and Dependents' Educational Assistance — copy of Certificate of Eligibility.
- # Chapter 1606: Montgomery GI Bill — Selected Reserve — copy of Certificate of Eligibility and a copy of your Notice of Basic Eligibility (DD Form 2384).
- # Chapter 1607: Reserve Education Assistance Program — copy of deployment orders, copy of redeployment orders and copy of your DD 214

If you are eligible for an Educational Bonus/Kicker (primarily Chapter 30/1606 recipients), you will also need to bring in the appropriate documentation to receive the benefit, e.g., DD 1131, Cash Collection Voucher, etc.
