Hi Pam,

Our office is interested in drafting an amendment to SB 179 relating to landlord and tenant laws. I noticed there are several drafters listed on the bill, but I figured I'd start here since you were listed first and I think this might be your area.

We'd like an amendment to retain the right for local municipalities to enact ordinances regulating the manufacturing or use of narcotics in order to promote public health or safety.

Basically, we've been looking into the issue of meth production in our region. We've heard that some municipalities may currently have local ordinances that dictate whether landlords must disclose prior meth use or production in a unit to a prospective tenant. We'd like to retain the local authority to enforce those safety measures.

We've heard SB 179 might get scheduled for a floor vote on Sept. 17th, so if you could get something to us by the end of the week we'd appreciate it. If you have any questions, please feel free to let me know.
