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

1 AN ACT relating to: ratification of the agreement negotiated between the state  
2 of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Building Trades Negotiating Committee,  
3 ~~AFL-CIO, and its appropriate affiliated locals, for the 2009-10 biennium,~~ <sup>2013-14</sup>  
4 covering employees in the building trades crafts collective bargaining unit, and  
5 authorizing an expenditure of funds.

**Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau**

This proposal is introduced under section 111.92 (1) of the statutes. The proposal ratifies the collective bargaining contract for state employees in the building trades crafts collective bargaining unit negotiated for the ~~2009-10~~ <sup>2013-14</sup> biennium under the State Employment Labor Relations Act. Currently, statutory program supplement appropriations fund the costs of collective bargaining agreements to the extent that they exceed budgeted costs. The proposal authorizes expenditure of moneys from those appropriations to fund the cost of this agreement.

**The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:**

**ASSEMBLY BILL 979**

**SECTION 1**

*2013-14 fiscal year*

1           **SECTION 1. Agreement Ratified.** The legislature ratifies the tentative  
 2 agreement negotiated for the ~~2009-10~~ *2013-14* ~~between~~ *between* the state of Wisconsin, the  
 3 office of state employment relations, and the Wisconsin State Building Trades  
 4 Negotiating Committee, ~~AFL-CIO~~ *AFL-CIO*, and its ~~appropriate affiliated locals~~ *appropriate affiliated locals*, covering  
 5 employees in the building trades crafts collective bargaining unit under subchapter  
 6 V of chapter 111 of the statutes, as approved by the employees of the building trades  
 7 crafts collective bargaining unit and approved and recommended by the joint  
 8 committee on employment relations, and authorizes the necessary expenditure of  
 9 moneys for implementation from the appropriations made by section 20.865 (1) of the  
 10 statutes, subject to section 20.865 (intro.) of the statutes. The director of the office  
 11 of state employment relations shall file an official copy of the agreement, certified by  
 12 the cochairpersons of the joint committee on employment relations, with the  
 13 secretary of state. No formal or informal agreement between the parties that is not  
 14 a part of the official copy is deemed to be approved by the legislature under this act.

**SECTION 2. Effective date.**

 16           (1) This act takes effect on the day ~~following~~ *e after* publication, except that those  
 17 provisions specifically identified as having other effective dates in the agreement  
 18 covering employees in the building trades crafts collective bargaining unit are  
 19 effective on the dates provided in that agreement.
