AN ACT to create 46.48 (32) of the statutes; relating to: grants to counties to

contract for peer-run respite centers and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Health Services (DHS) to award grants to counties to contract with peer-run organizations to establish peer-run respite centers for individuals experiencing mental health conditions or substance abuse. The total amount of general purpose revenue appropriated to be awarded as grants is \$250,000 under the bill. For each grant awarded, DHS shall award the county an amount that is one-half the amount the county provides to contract with the peer-run organization to establish peer-run respite centers.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

8 amount is increased by \$125,000 for the first fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in
9 which this subsection takes effect to provide grants to counties to contract with
10 peer-run organizations to establish peer-run respite centers. In the schedule under
11 section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of health
12 services under section 20.435 (5) (bc) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2013,
13 the dollar amount is increased by \$125,000 for the second fiscal year of the fiscal
14 biennium in which this subsection takes effect to provide grants to counties to
15 contract with peer-run organizations to establish peer-run respite centers.

October 28, 2013 – Offered by Representative JAGLER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 1: delete the material beginning with “grants” and ending with
3 “contract for” on line 2 and substitute “contracts for establishing”. AA1-1

4 **2.** Page 1, line 3: before that line insert:

5 **SECTION 1g.** 20.435 (5) (bc) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 20.435 (5) (bc) *Grants for community programs.* The amounts in the schedule
7 for grants for and contracts to establish community programs under s. 46.48.
8 Notwithstanding ss. 20.001 (3) (a) and 20.002 (1), the department may transfer funds
9 between fiscal years under this paragraph. Except for amounts authorized to be
10 carried forward under s. 46.48 and as otherwise provided in this paragraph, all funds
11 allocated but not encumbered by December 31 of each year lapse to the general fund
12 on the next January 1 unless carried forward to the next calendar year by the joint
13 committee on finance. Notwithstanding ss. 20.001 (3) (a) and 20.002 (1), the

1 department shall transfer from this appropriation account to the appropriation
2 account for the department of children and families under s. 20.437 (2) (dz) funds
3 allocated by the department under s. 46.48 (30) but unexpended on June 30 of each
4 year”.

5 **3.** Page 1, line 3: delete “SECTION 1” and substitute “SECTION 1r”.

7 “counties to” on line 5.

8 **5.** Page 2, line 1: ~~delete~~ the material beginning with “The department” and
9 ending with “centers.” on line 3.

10 **6.** Page 2, line 9: ~~delete~~ “to provide grants to counties”.

11 **7.** Page 2, line 14: ~~delete~~ “to provide grants to counties”.
