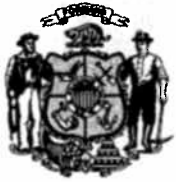

Opioid Treatment Program

Section 2. 51.422 of the statutes is created to read:

51.422 Opioid treatment programs. (1) PROGRAM CREATION.....

(2) Program Components. An opioid treatment program created under this section shall offer an assessment to individuals in need of services to determine what type of treatment is needed. The program shall transition individuals to a licensed residential program, if that level of treatment is necessary. The program shall provide counseling, medication-assisted treatment, including both FDA-approved long acting opioid antagonist and partial agonist medications, and abstinence-based treatment. The program shall transition individuals who have completed treatment to county-based or private post-treatment care.
