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

Mike,

After the hearing yesterday, some items came up that we want to amend.

Under Section 1: Identification card, can we add out of state driver's license and identification cards, also passports from another country. The reason this came up was for the students at Universities. That was an oversight on my part.

Next, there was a concern regarding long term care facilities. Here is some language from North Carolina

12. Does this statute apply when dispensing to patients in hospitals or other health care facilities?

No. The statute excludes dispensing in "health care facilities, as that term is defined in G.S. 131E-256(b), when the controlled substances are delivered to the health care facilities for the benefit of residents or patients of such health care facilities." G.S. 131E-256(b) includes adult care homes, hospitals, home care agencies, hospices, nursing facilities, and "community based providers of services for the mentally ill, the developmentally disabled, and substance abusers that are not required to be licensed under Article 2 of Chapter 122C of the General Statutes."
