## 2013 SENATE BILL 237

July 31, 2013 – Introduced by Senators GROTHMAN, L. TAYLOR, KEDZIE, PETROWSKI and OLSEN, cosponsored by Representatives KOOYENGA, KRUG, MURPHY, A. OTT, HONADEL, POPE, SPIROS, CRAIG and DOYLE. Referred to Committee on Health and Human Services.

2             and 454.26 (2); and **to create** 454.01 (7m) (am) of the statutes; **relating to:**

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill makes several changes to the laws governing barbering and cosmetology in Wisconsin, including the following:

1. Under current law, barbering includes dyeing, tinting, coloring, or bleaching a person's hair. The bill removes those activities from the scope of the practice of barbering in Wisconsin.

2. Under current law, a course of instruction in barbering must include at least 1,000 classroom hours, and those classroom hours must be spread out over at least 10 months. The bill eliminates that 10-month requirement.

3. Current law requires that an apprentice in barbering must complete at least 3,712 hours of practical training and 288 classroom hours before the apprentice may sit for the examination to become a licensed barber. Under the bill, an apprentice in barbering must complete at least 1,712 hours of practical training and 288 classroom hours before the apprentice may sit for the examination to become a licensed barber.

4. Under current law, a course of instruction in barbering or in cosmetology may not exceed eight hours in one day or 48 hours in one week. The bill eliminates that limitation.

11           **SECTION 3.** 454.01 (7m) (am) of the statutes is created to read:

12           454.01 (7m) (am) Dyeing, tinting, coloring, bleaching, or performing similar  
13 work upon the hair of the head, neck, or face of any person by any means.

14           **SECTION 4.** 454.20 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

15           454.20 (2) "Barbering" means, for compensation, arranging, styling, dressing,  
16 shampooing, cleansing, curling, ~~dyeing, tinting, coloring, bleaching,~~ waving,  
17 straightening, cutting, shaving, trimming, relaxing, singeing, or performing similar  
18 work upon the hair of the head, neck, or face of any person by any means. "Barbering"  
19 does not include the removal of a person's hair at the root or the application of  
20 temporary or permanent eyelash extensions to the eyelashes of a person.
