9 (1) SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR SHEBOYGAN TUBERCULOSIS RESPONSE
10 FUNDING. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the
11 appropriation to the joint committee on finance under section 20.865 (4) (a) of the
12 statutes, as affected by the acts of 2013, the dollar amount is decreased by \$175,000
13 for the second fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this subsection takes effect
14 to reduce by \$175,000 the amounts allocated to the appropriation by 2013 Wisconsin
15 Act 20, section 9118 (1e).
