

So it would create an exception to s. 66.0436 (2), which would say something like "A 1st class city may use a definition of food handler, as defined in s. 254.71 (1g) (d), that also includes an individual who is engaged in the service of food and who is not a certificate holder, as defined in s. 254.71 (1g) (b)." If this sounds good, I would renumber s. 66.0436 (2) to be s. 66.0436 (2) (a) and make this provision s. 66.0436 (2) (b).

Let me know and/or feel free to run it by whoever you need to and I will do the amendment.

Mike, we need to make a change to SB 343 (LRB 3635). Could you draft an amendment for the following for both the Senate and Assembly versions of the bill? I've cc'd Hariah from Rep. Thiesfeldt's office in as well.

Page 3 line 15 & 16 remove "or service" so it reads – (d) "Food handler" means an individual who is engaged in the preparation (or) processing ~~or service~~ of food at a restaurant and who is not a certificate holder.

Finally, can we exempt first class cities from this specific change? Milwaukee currently includes service and we don't want to change things on their end.
