In a school setting the volunteer health care provider may only provide services to students from 4-year-old kindergarten to grade 6, may only provide the services described under current law, and must provide the services without charge at the school. Current law makes a volunteer health care provider providing services under the program an agent of the state for certain purposes including representation by the attorney general in a civil action or other matter brought before a court or administrative agency; mandatory filing of a notice of claim before bringing a civil claim against the agent; and payment by the state of a judgment of damages and costs against the agent when the agency is found to be acting within the scope of employment.

This bill adds all of the following health care professionals to those who may participate in, and receive the protections of, the volunteer health care provider program: nurse aides, emergency medical technicians, psychologists, certified social workers, licensed marriage and family therapists, licensed professional counselors, advanced practice nurses who are certified to issue prescription orders, medical assistants who hold certain certifications, health educators meeting certain criteria, and dental assistants. Also, the bill exempts certain advanced practice nurses who are certified to issue prescription orders from current law requirements to provide proof of financial responsibility and maintain malpractice insurance while those advanced practice nurses are serving as a volunteer health care provider under the program.


