Rep. Kessler would like to have an amendment to AB 620 drafted that would make it the lowest level misdemeanor if the presentencing report is not kept confidential according to Sec. 47 of the bill and Statute Sec. 972.15 (4m). Rep. Kessler is worried that when the DA's office is sharing the presentencing report with the victim, per AB 620, that the victim's advocate will be there to see the report and that possibly the defendant's confidential information will be shared with the victim or the victim's advocate.
