



2013 ASSEMBLY BILL 716

1 **AN ACT to amend** 343.20 (1) (a) of the statutes; **relating to:** expiration of motor
2 vehicle operators' licenses issued after cancellation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 343.20 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 343.20 (1) (a) Except as otherwise expressly provided in this chapter,
5 probationary licenses issued under s. 343.085, ~~licenses issued after cancellation~~
6 ~~under s. 343.26 (1),~~ and original licenses other than instruction permits shall expire
7 2 years from the date of the applicant's next birthday. Licenses issued after
8 cancellation shall expire on the expiration date for the prior license at the time of
9 cancellation. Subject to s. 343.125 (3), all other licenses and license endorsements
10 shall expire 8 years after the date of issuance. The department may institute any

1 system of initial license issuance which it deems advisable for the purpose of gaining
2 a uniform rate of renewals. In order to put such a system into operation, the
3 department may issue licenses which are valid for any period less than the ordinary
4 effective period of such license. If the department issues a license that is valid for
5 less than the ordinary effective period as authorized by this paragraph, the fees due
6 under s. 343.21 (1) (b) and (d) shall be prorated accordingly.

7 **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**

8 (1) This act first applies to applications for operators' licenses received by the
9 department of transportation on the effective date of this subsection.
