Description Certification cards to carry concealed weapons for residents of Wisconsin who formerly were employed as law enforcement officers in another state					

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under s. 175.49(3), upon the request of a former federal law enforcement officer, DOJ may issue a certification card qualifying the officer to carry a certain firearm concealed if the officer meets certain conditions. The certification card is issued at the expense of the officer. The fee for a former federal law enforcement officer certification is \$25.

Under AB 165, s. 175.49(3) is expanded to apply to former out-of-state law enforcement officers.

Should AB 165 be enacted, DOJ will have to make relatively minor adjustments to the paper and electronic concealed carry application and to the concealed carry portion of its website to reflect its new responsibilities regarding approving and issuing concealed carry certification cards to former out-of-state law enforcement officers. DOJ anticipates processing the unknown number of out-of-state law enforcement officer certification applications with existing staff. DOJ further anticipates setting the fee for an out-of-state law enforcement officer certification at \$25 to cover related expenses.
