Description Court orders regarding the installation of an ignition interlock device					

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law allows a court to order an ignition interlock device (IID) be installed immediately upon issuing the order that a person's operating privilege be restricted to operating a vehicle with an IID installed. This bill, if enacted, would require a court to order an IID be installed within three working days of an order restricting a person's operating privileges.

Prosecutors believe that the number who contest OWI first offense violations would not change significantly if this bill were enacted because it requires the installation of an IID within three days of an order, which may be more lenient than in some cases under current law. Prosecutors do not anticipate a fiscal impact on their offices should this bill be enacted.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Should this bill be enacted, prosecutors do not expect there to be a long-term fiscal impact on their offices.
