Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, employees of the Department of Transportation (DOT) are exempt from any licensure requirement while engaged in activities relating to land surveying. This bill removes this particular exemption.

As of July 1, 2013, all DOT Survey Coordinators and Right-of-Way Plat Coordinators are required to have a Registered Land Surveyor license. The policy to require Registered Land Surveyor licenses was put in place in 2009 and became effective on July 1, 2013. As current DOT policy requires the staff, who engage in activities relating to land surveying, to be licensed, the proposal will have no fiscal impact on DOT.
