Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, before a state agency may submit a proposed administrative rule to the Legislative Council Staff for review, the agency must prepare an economic impact analysis for the proposed rule. The economic impact analysis must contain, among other things, an analysis of the actual and quantifiable benefits of the proposed rule. This bill would require the economic impact analysis to include an assessment of the impact that the proposed rule will have on public health and the environment.

The bill will have an indeterminate fiscal impact on the Department of Administration (DOA). DOA rules rarely have public health or environmental impacts; therefore, DOA is not anticipated to incur significant costs in terms of man hours or additional research as a result of AB 597.
