<b>Description</b> Agricultural emergency permits issued by the Department of Transportation for vehicles transporting oversized loads					

### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB-647 modifies the issuance of an agriculture emergency permit by the Department of Transportation (DOT). Upon determination by the Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection (DATCP) that an agriculture emergency exists, DOT would be able to issue agriculture emergency permits for vehicles transporting baled straw, cornstalks, or stover if these products are to be used for feed or bedding. Baled hay would also be able to be transported under an agricultural emergency permit if it is only to be used for feed or bedding. The bill also modifies the height and width requirements for vehicles issued an agricultural emergency permit and is not limited to the operation of commercial motor vehicles on interstate highways.

There is no fiscal effect on DATCP attributed to this bill.
