Description Cost threshold for applicability of the prevailing wage law to a project of public works					

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill raises the cost threshold for applying the prevailing wage law to projects of public works. This bill would raise that cost threshold to \$96,000 for single-trade projects and \$200,000 for multiple-trade projects. It would also raise the threshold for multiple-trade projects constructed for a city or village having a population of less than 2,500 or for a town to \$468,000.

The DWD Equal Rights Division estimates there would be approximately 24% fewer covered projects under the changes outlined in AB 831. However, the DWD Equal Rights Division does not project a reduction in the number of complaints that would need to be investigated. Investigations are often prompted by third party organizations that ask the Equal Rights Division to investigate particular projects. The DWD Equal Rights Division projects those organizations will continue to be active and focus their requests on other covered projects.
