Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits a person from smoking in a motor vehicle while a person under age 16 is in the vehicle.

Prosecutors believe that any extra work created by this bill would be handled primarily by municipal courts and municipal attorneys, not by prosecutors in the District Attorney's office. Consequently, should this bill be enacted, prosecutors do not expect there to be any fiscal impact on their offices.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Prosecutors do not anticipate any long-term fiscal effect on their offices should this bill be enacted.
