Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill eliminates the statute of limitations on an action to collect child or family support, allowing a person to bring an action to collect amounts owed at any time.

Prosecutors believe this will affect only collection actions, but not prosecutors; so, they do not expect any fiscal impact on District Attorney offices should this bill be enacted.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

If enacted, prosecutors do not believe this bill will have a long-term fiscal effect on their offices.
