## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits a person from falsifying data from a motor vehicle emission inspection report.

District Attorneys believe that this bill, if enacted, will increase the number of cases they prosecute, but it will not be by a significant number. They anticipate that any increase in costs will be negligible. Consequently, DAs expect that this bill would have no fiscal effect on their offices.
